

## CENTRAL QUEENSLAND CUE SPORTS INC.

### GRADING POLICY

CQ Grading based on results from Central Queensland City v Country past events and other events.

Gradings are based on the below formulas

If played 24 frames and won 18 frames or more you MUST play one grade higher the following year (75.00%) 2014, 2015, 2016

If played 24 frames and won 17 frames or more you MUST play one grade higher the following year (70.83%) 2016

If played 20 frames and won 14 frames or more you MUST play one grade higher the following year (70.00%) 2016

If played 24 frames and won 16 frames or more you should consider one grade higher the following year (66.66%)

If played 24 frames and won 12 frames or more you should stay in the current grade (50.00%)

If played 24 frames and won 11 frames or less you may be allow to play one grade lower the following year (45.83%)

Players are also graded on their known ability.

**STATE QEBF GRADING:** CQ also grade Players for State Events (including Qld Cup),

the general assumption is that CQ players overall are 10% below the Playing Ability of SEQ Players and are graded accordingly

Associations may appeal a Players Grading if their associations statistics are substantially lower.
